- The number of LAT prescribed is for indicative purpose only. The subject teachers can conduct more number LATs as based upon the learning outcomes to be attained.
- MDP should be planned judiciously in subject committee meeting and in collaboration with the subject teachers of other subjects of the respective class. It should be based on the guidelines of NEP 2020.
- In Class-II, out of 10 cycle tests the best 8 cycle tests to be taken into consideration and will be reflected in report card.
- Split-Up Syllabus prescribed by KVS and CBSE are strictly to be followed to ensure timely completion of syllabus. For the time being Split-up of the last session to be followed.
- Syllabus for Classes X & XII to be completed by 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 positively.
